

TAKEDABUDO DANSHINSA

Minimal required time between grades:

8 kyu – 1 KYU	To become 1e KYU, 144 weeks are needed at the rate of 1 class per week (± 3½ à 4 years)
1 kyu – 1 DAN	To become 1e DAN, 45 weeks are needed (± 1½ à 2 years) + participation in seminars
1 dan - 2 DAN	To become 2e DAN, 3 years are needed + participation in seminars
2 dan - 3 DAN	To become 3e DAN, 4 years are needed + participation in seminars
3 dan - 4 DAN	To become 4e DAN, 5 years are needed + participation in seminars
4 dan – 5 DAN	To become 5e DAN, 6 years are needed + participation in seminars

Do not compare yourself to others, each individual is different. Practising 2 trainings per week for the same discipline or practising during the vacations reduces the required time. (Must be validated by the Sensei)

TAKEDABUDO DANSHINSA

The DANSHINSA examination is held by the presentation of 3 exams : KATA-FREE / SHIAI / KATA-TEST

PREREQUISITES:

- Be in order with NSR fees

NOTE:

- The presence of the teacher is desired at each test
- The candidate can only present a maximum of 2 tests on the same event: either shiai in 2 different disciplines, or a shiai and a kata-test in the same discipline or in different disciplines, or two kata-tests in different disciplines
- To pass, you must obtain for each test the following note: either a 'very good' which, to give an order, would be equivalent to a 9/10, or two 'good' which would be equivalent to a 16/20, or three 'satisfactory' which would be equivalent to a 21/30.

1° STEP: Free exam: KATA-FREE

- 1.1 Either the candidate informs the teacher of his wish to take a DAN level, or the teacher, judging that the candidate is fit to take the exam, informs the candidate who is free to accept.
- 1.2 Prior to a candidate's request for an examination, <u>the teacher must check the knowledge</u> corresponding to the level requested (including etiquette).
- 1.3 The candidate must prepare a free work of his choice (KATA-FREE) of maximum 3 minutes including the etiquette and whose performance corresponds to the level requested.
- 1.4 The candidate presents his KATA-FREE during a class or seminar in the presence of one or more of the DANSHINSA members, otherwise the teacher or the candidate sends a video to the examination committee for comment. (Via a platform for sending large files such as https://www.grosfichiers.com/fr/ indicating the email link danshinsa@takedabudo.com and in the title the name of the candidate and the grade requested)
- 1.5 In case of validation by the danshisa members, the candidate can take the SHIAI test.

2° STEP: Fight exam: SHIAI

- 2.1 The candidate must take for his combat test 3 shiai on the same day.
- 2.2 The SOGO Shiai test is not mandatory and can be replaced by a TWR Shiai at the request of the candidate who will specify it beforehand.
- 2.3 If the level required is reached, the candidate can take the KATA-TEST.
- 2.4 The candidate will pay the examination fee directly to the teacher before the last test.

3° STEP: Imposed exam: KATA-TEST

- 3.1 The candidate must be accompanied by his Uke, otherwise a Uke will be designated and in case of absence of Uke, the test will be postponed.
- 3.2 The candidate is judged on his role as Tori and his role as Uke
- 3.3 In case of success, the grade is notified in the budo-passport and the teacher will order the degree via the NSR administration without forgetting to indicate the date of the kata-test.

For the administration section: Upon successful completion of the degree, the club instructor will include, in the annual NSR administration, the order and payment of the degrees.
